

Distance Learning Dress Code for Students

Although the normal dress code expectations (uniforms) are being relaxed during this time, online learners are still required to wear appropriate clothing for Zoom classes and other online meetings. This includes:

- **Covering** the top half with an appropriate shirt, top, or polo
- **Covering** the bottom half with pants, shorts, skirts, or a dress
- All clothing should be free of **inappropriate** graphics or **any** words other than Rogers Spirit Wear.

Not allowed:

- Symbols, mottos, words or acronyms that convey crude, vulgar, profane, violent, death-oriented, gang-related, sexually explicit, or sexually suggestive messages.
- Symbols, mottos, words or acronyms advertising tobacco, alcohol, or illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia.
